

<p style="text-align: center;">BURY LADIES NETBALL LEAGUE CONSTITUTION (October 2006)</p>
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1. Name

The amalgamation of Teams shall be known as "THE BURY LADIES NETBALL LEAGUE" hereinafter referred to as "THE LEAGUE".

2. Membership

- i) The membership of the League shall be made up of all the registered teams and shall consist of not less than eight teams.
- ii) Teams wishing to re-apply and those wishing to resign from the League, shall do so by the 30th April.
- iii) All teams shall be eligible to pay a registration fee which shall be determined by the Management Committee and payable by the 30th April for the following season. Any team not paying by the 30th April shall be deemed to have resigned from the League.
- iv) All team members must be affiliated and insured with AENA.

3. Management

- i) The League shall be administered by a Management Committee which shall be elected annually at the AGM.
- ii) The Management Committee shall comprise of the Chairperson, Vice Chairperson, Treasurer and Secretaries of the League.
- iii) All correspondence shall be addressed and forwarded to the League Secretary.
- iv) Nominations for the positions of President and Vice President shall be put to and voted on by the Management Committee.

4. Annual General Meeting

The Annual General Meeting shall normally be held in August and each team shall be represented.

The Annual General Meeting shall transact the following business:-

- a) Minutes of previous AGM
- b) Election of Officers
- c) Reports from Officers
- d) Presentation of Audited Accounts
- e) Any other relevant business

5. Extraordinary General Meeting

Any team member has a right to request an Extraordinary General Meeting. This request must be forwarded to the League Secretary not less than fourteen days prior to the requested date and accompanied by the signatures of twenty team representatives. The League Secretary will call the meeting.

6. Finance

- i) The funds of the League shall be lodged in a bank account approved by the Management Committee.
- ii) The Treasurer shall be responsible for managing the financial affairs of the League.
- iii) An annual statement of expenditure and income shall be presented to the AGM.
- iv) Expenses will be paid to officials from the League funds.
- v) If the League is in debt, each team shall be called upon to contribute equally to the paying of such debt.
- vi) Toll money shall be payable for each match. Half of the seasons toll money must be paid by the December meeting. Teams with outstanding toll money after the December meeting shall have their next match declared void and any subsequent match thereafter until the outstanding money is paid. The second half of the seasons toll money must be paid by 31st March. The Management Committee may expel from the League any teams with outstanding toll monies at the 31st March.
- vii) In the event of any team resigning during the season all monies will be forfeited to the League funds.

7. Alterations to the Constitution

- i) Proposal for alterations to the Constitution should be notified in writing to the League Secretary no later than 30th June.
- ii) Any alterations to the Constitution will require the approval of a two-thirds majority of those present and voting at the Annual General Meeting.

8. Dissolution

The League may be dissolved at any time by a resolution passed by two thirds majority of those present and voting at an Extraordinary General Meeting.
